





4. Number of Published Articles (results by year)





5. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2019





6. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2019





In 2018, 58 surgeons, including 23 attending surgeons and 35 clinical fellows and residents performed 14,054 cases of thoracic surgeries, including 11,958 pulmonary procedures, 866 esophageal procedures, 957 mediastinal procedures, 45 trachea procedures, and 7 lung transplantations, increased by 13.9% compared with the previous year.

As an academic bridge connecting the thoracic specialists globally and the Shanghai Chest Hospital, this column features on the annual report of thoracic surgery service at Shanghai Chest Hospital. 




