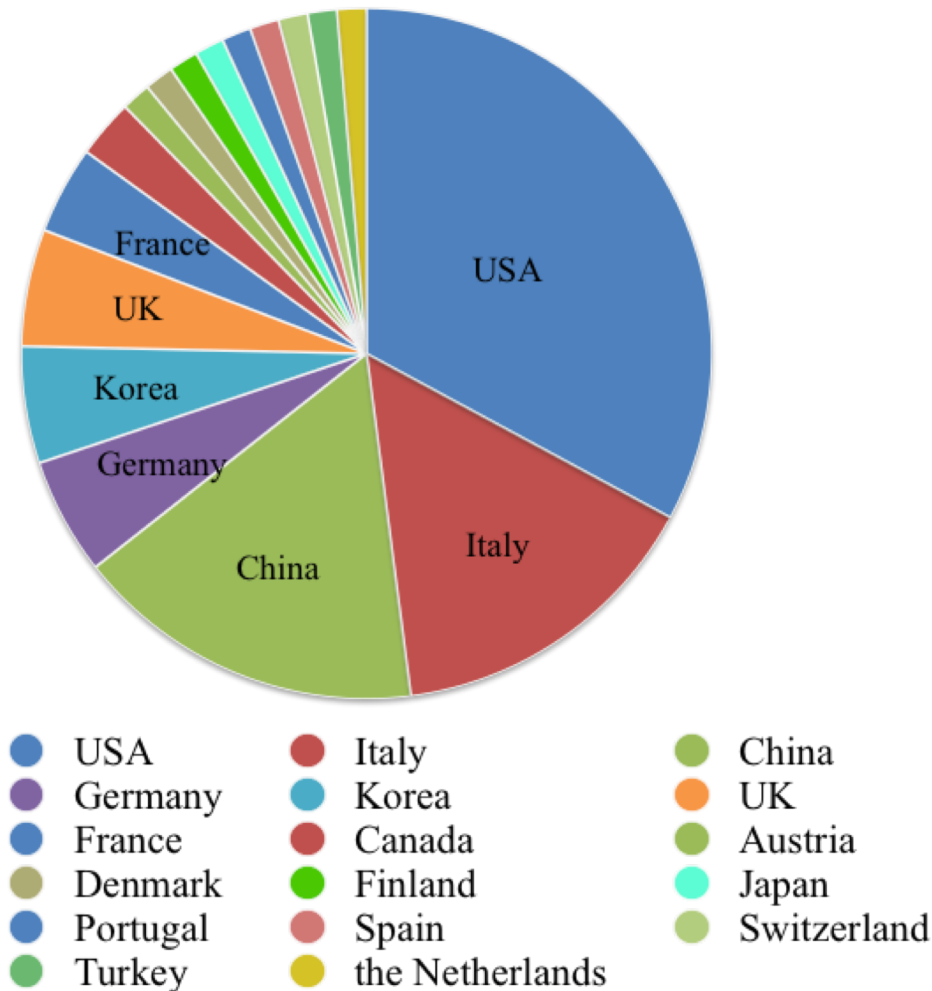

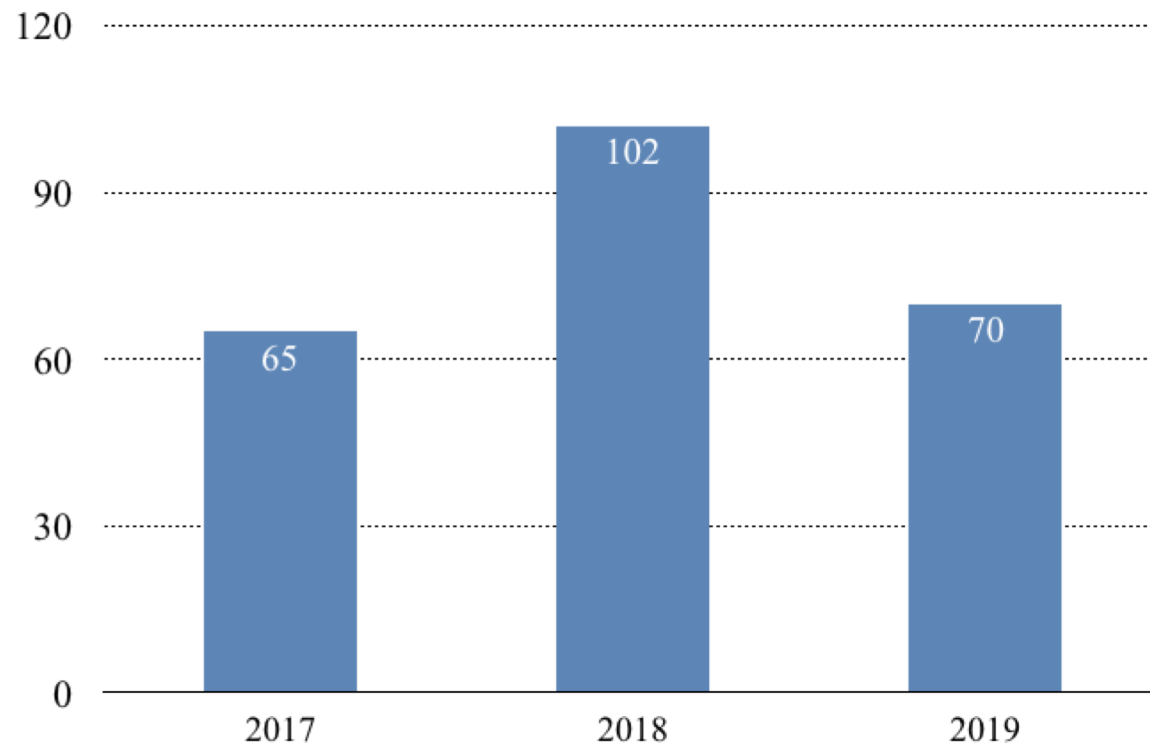

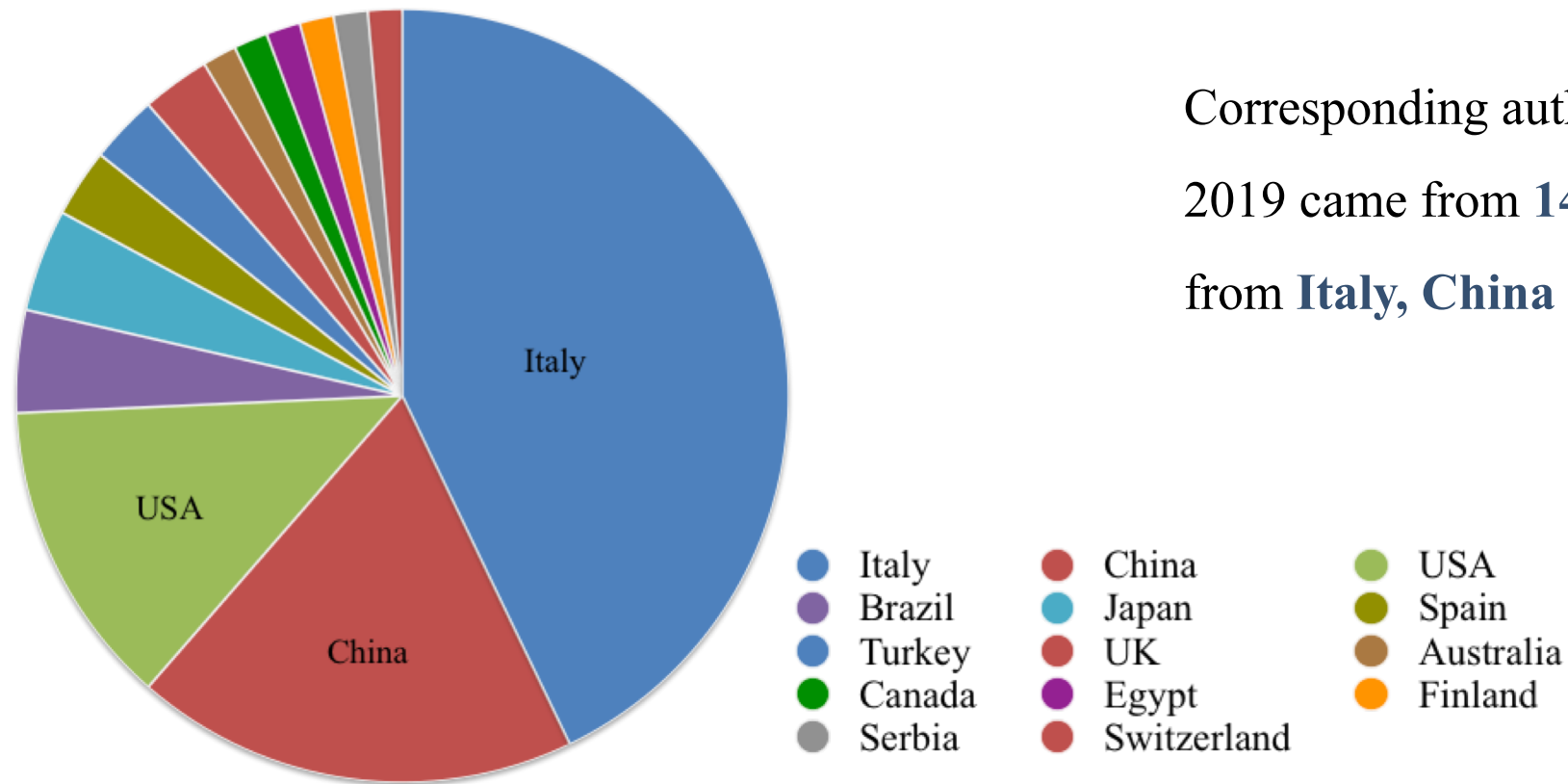

## 6. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2019



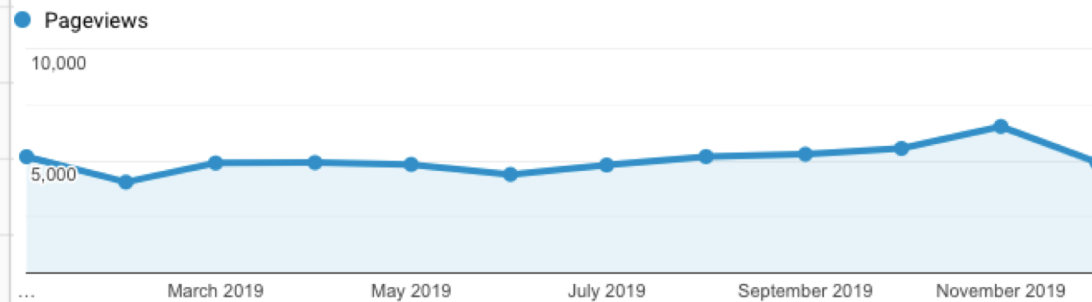
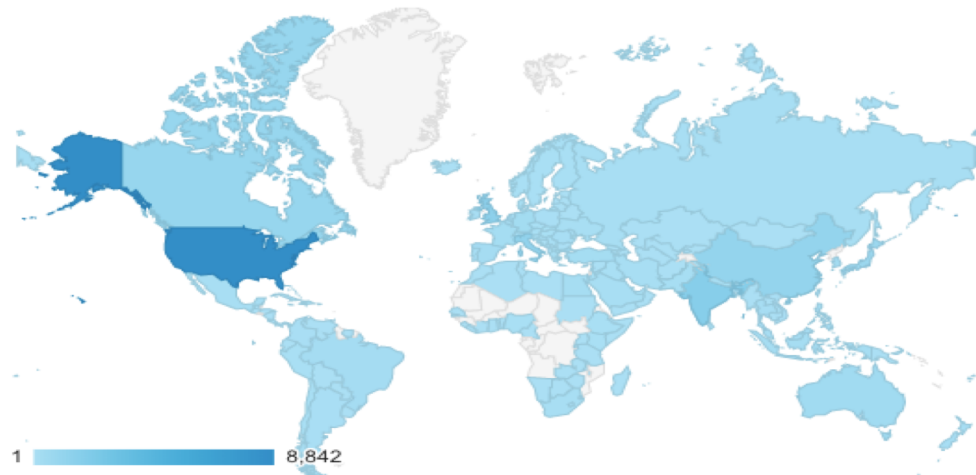
Corresponding authors of **70** articles in 2019 came from **14** countries with mostly from **Italy, China and USA**.

In 2018, 58 surgeons, including 23 attending surgeons and 35 clinical fellows and residents performed 14,054 cases of thoracic surgeries, including 11,958 pulmonary procedures, 866 esophageal procedures, 957 mediastinal procedures, 45 trachea procedures, and 7 lung transplantations, increased by 13.9% compared with the previous year.

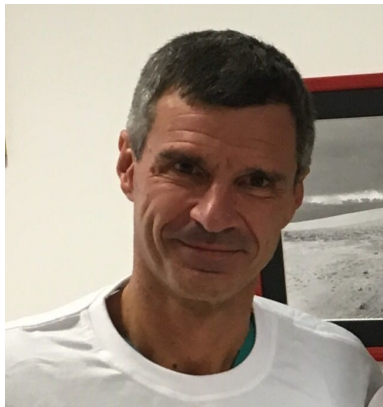
