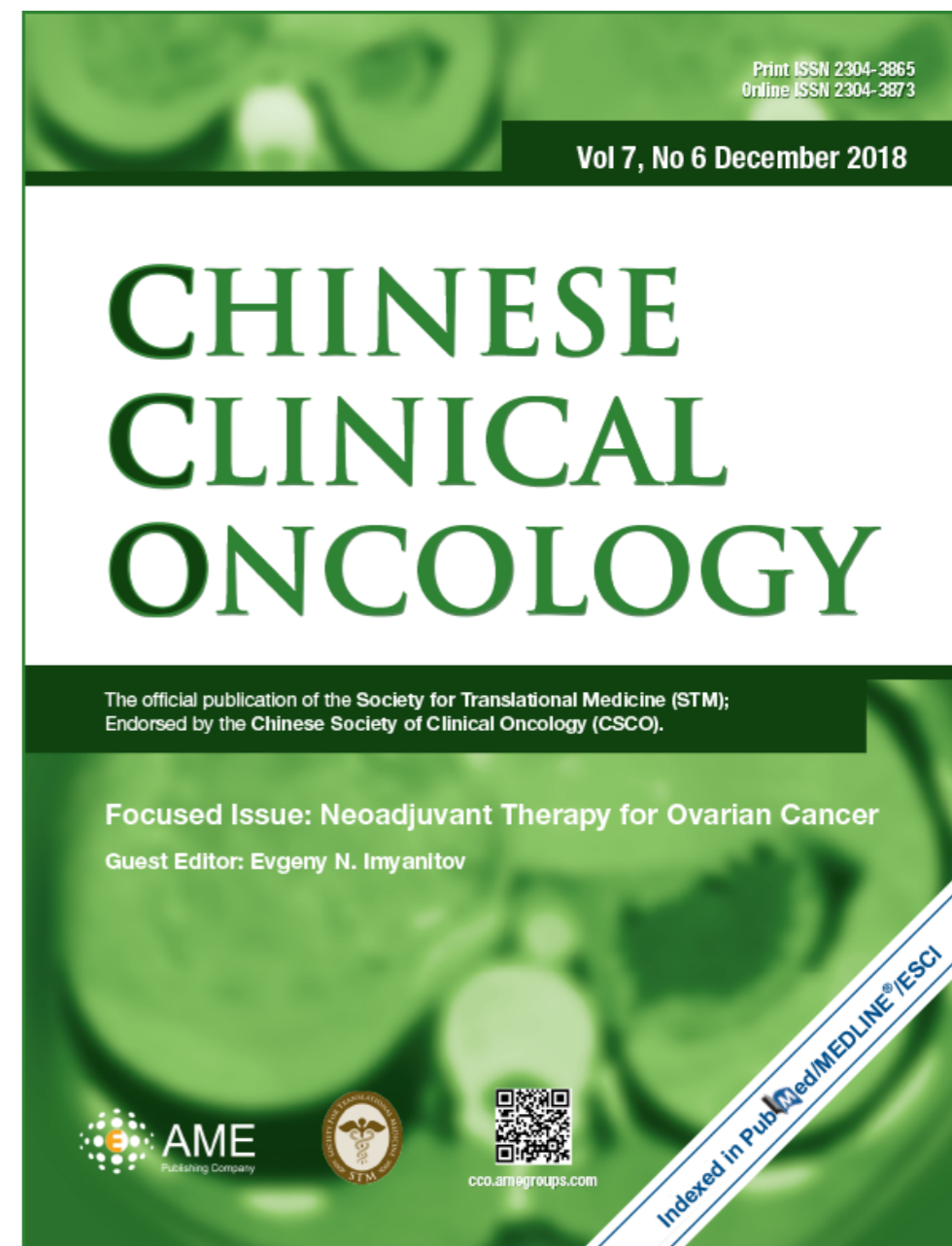

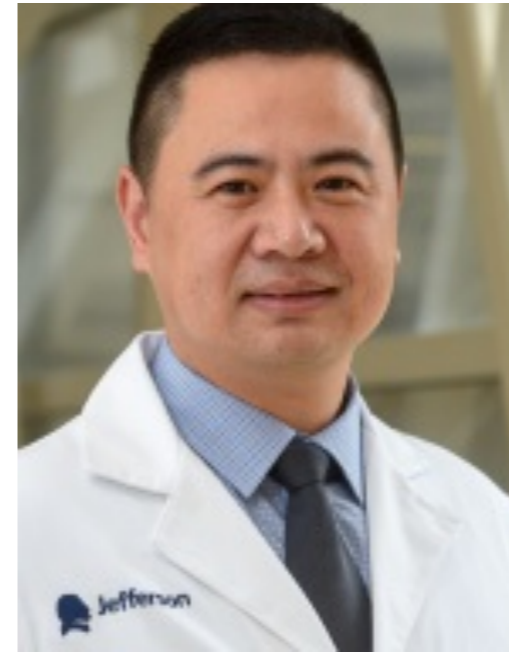

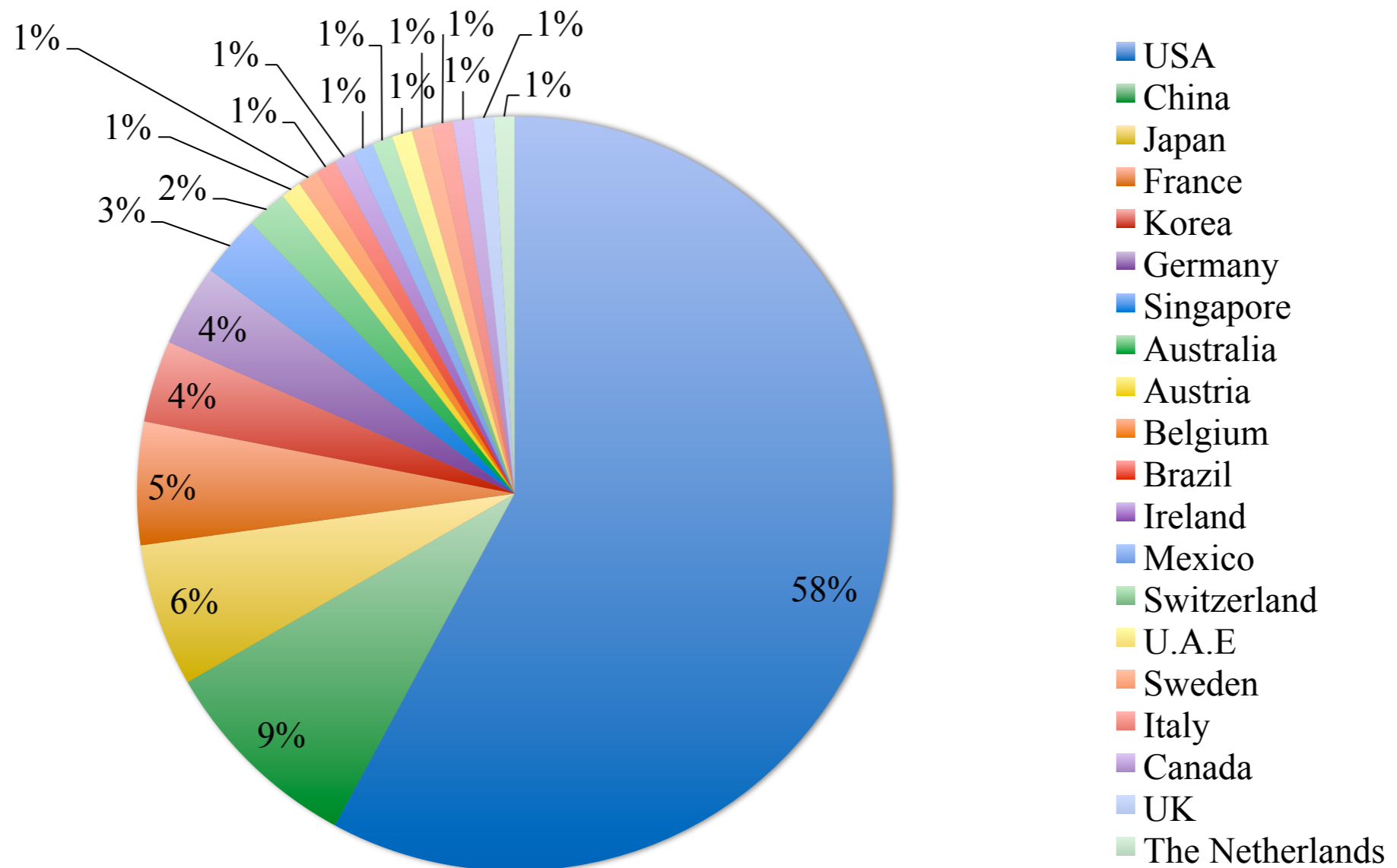

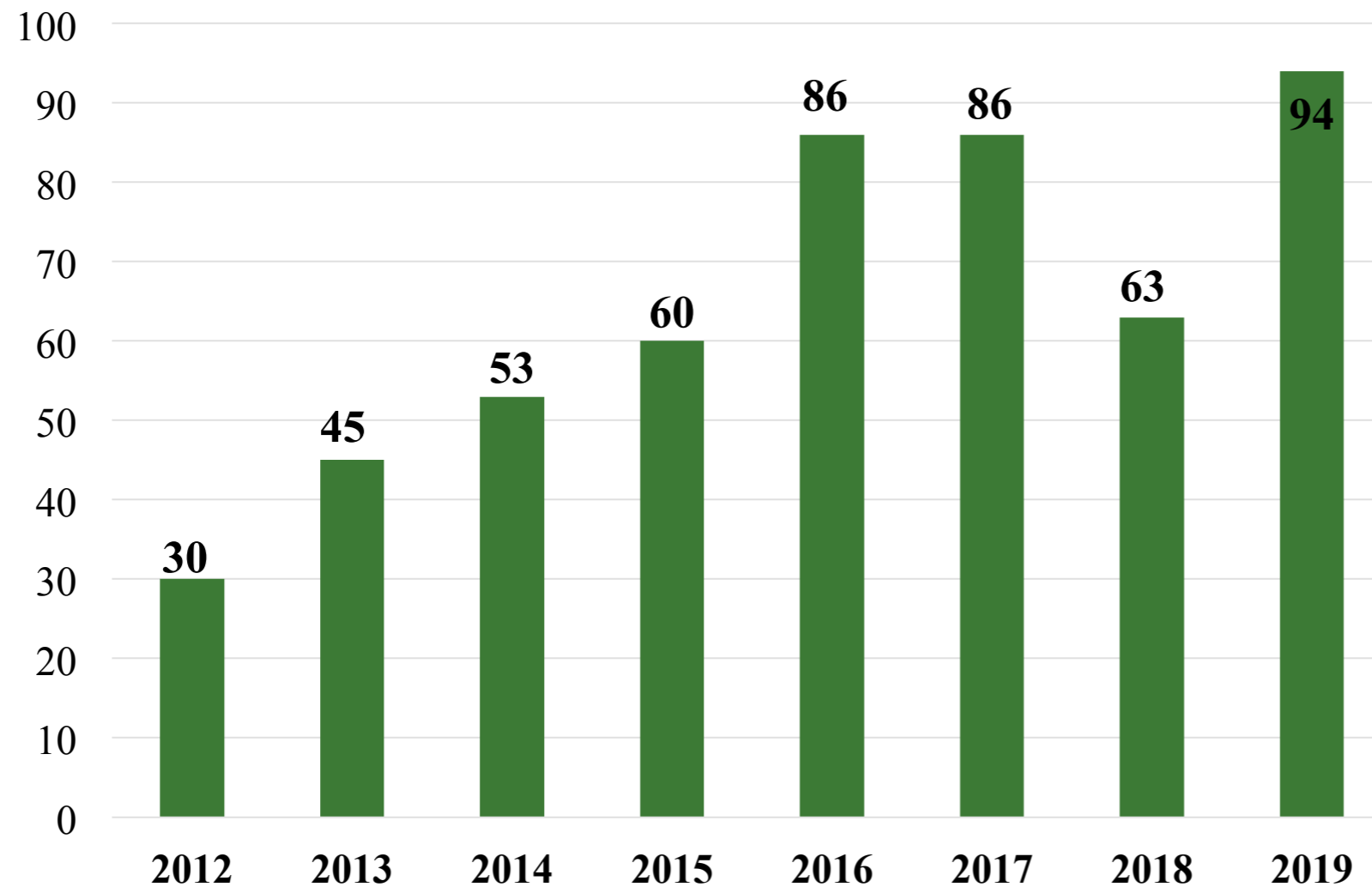

4. Number of Published Articles (results by year)

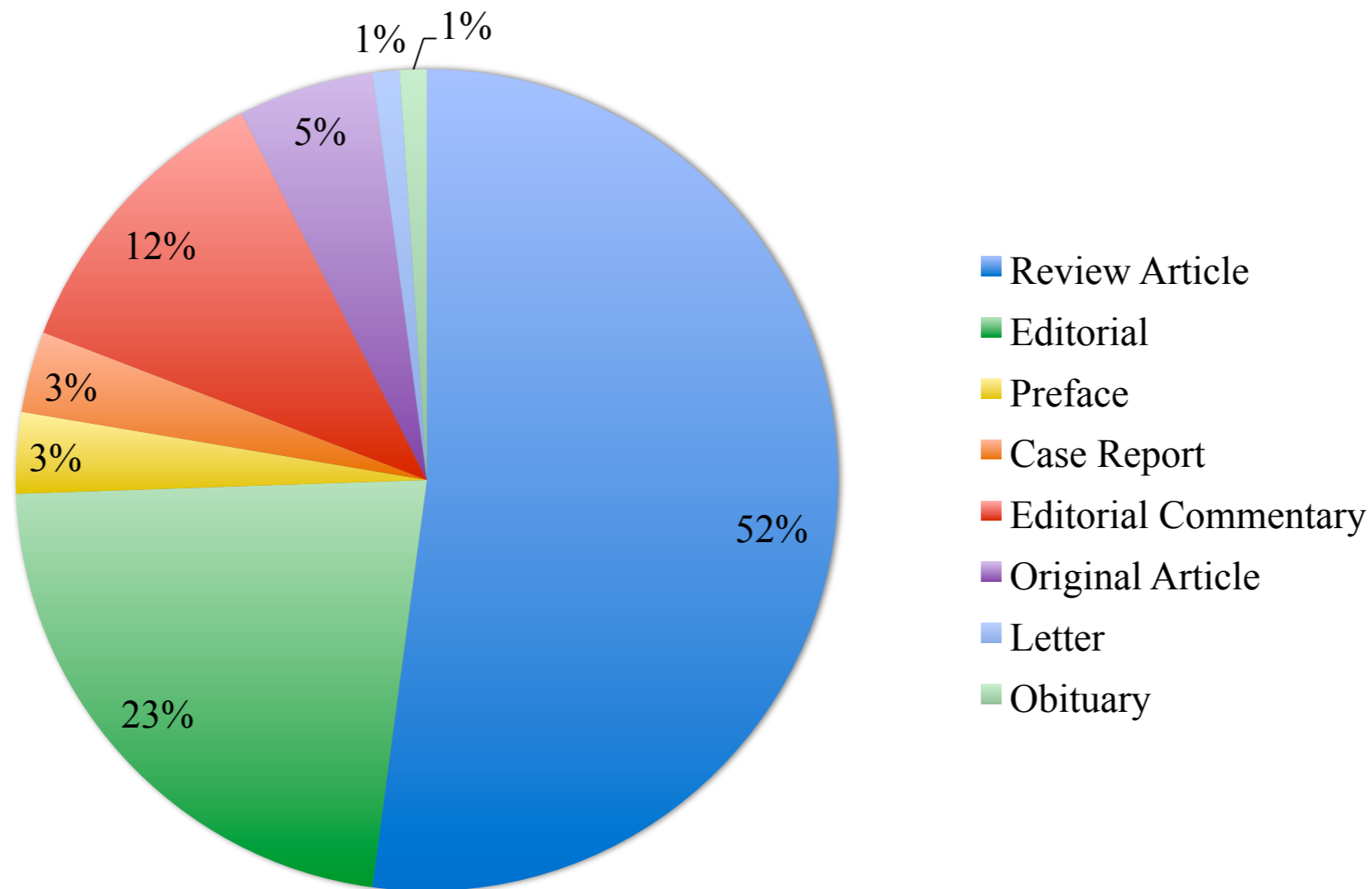

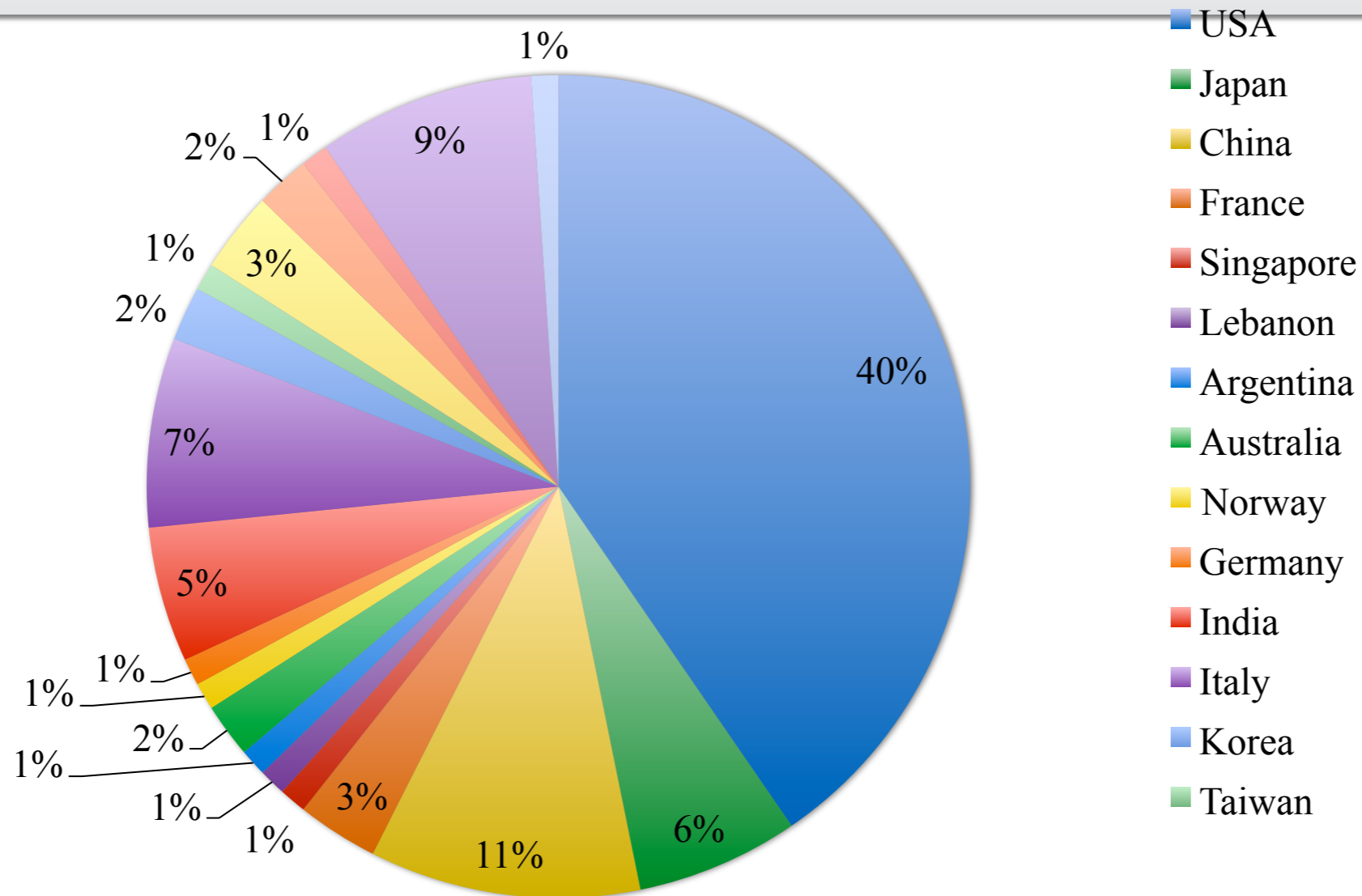
5. Types of Article Published in 2019

In 2019, CCO has published a total of **94 manuscripts**, including **54 Review** Articles and **Original** Articles in total.

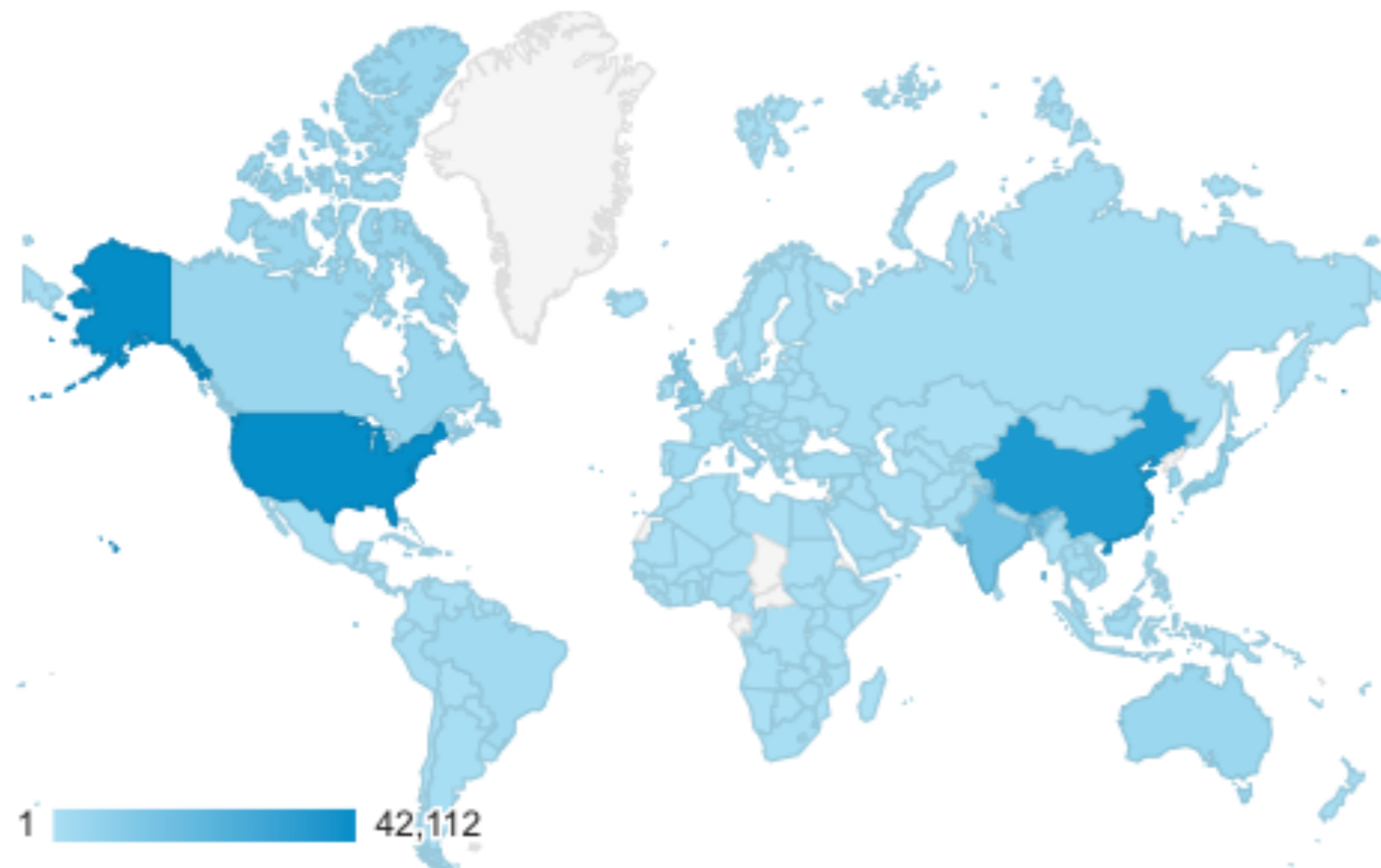


6. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2018

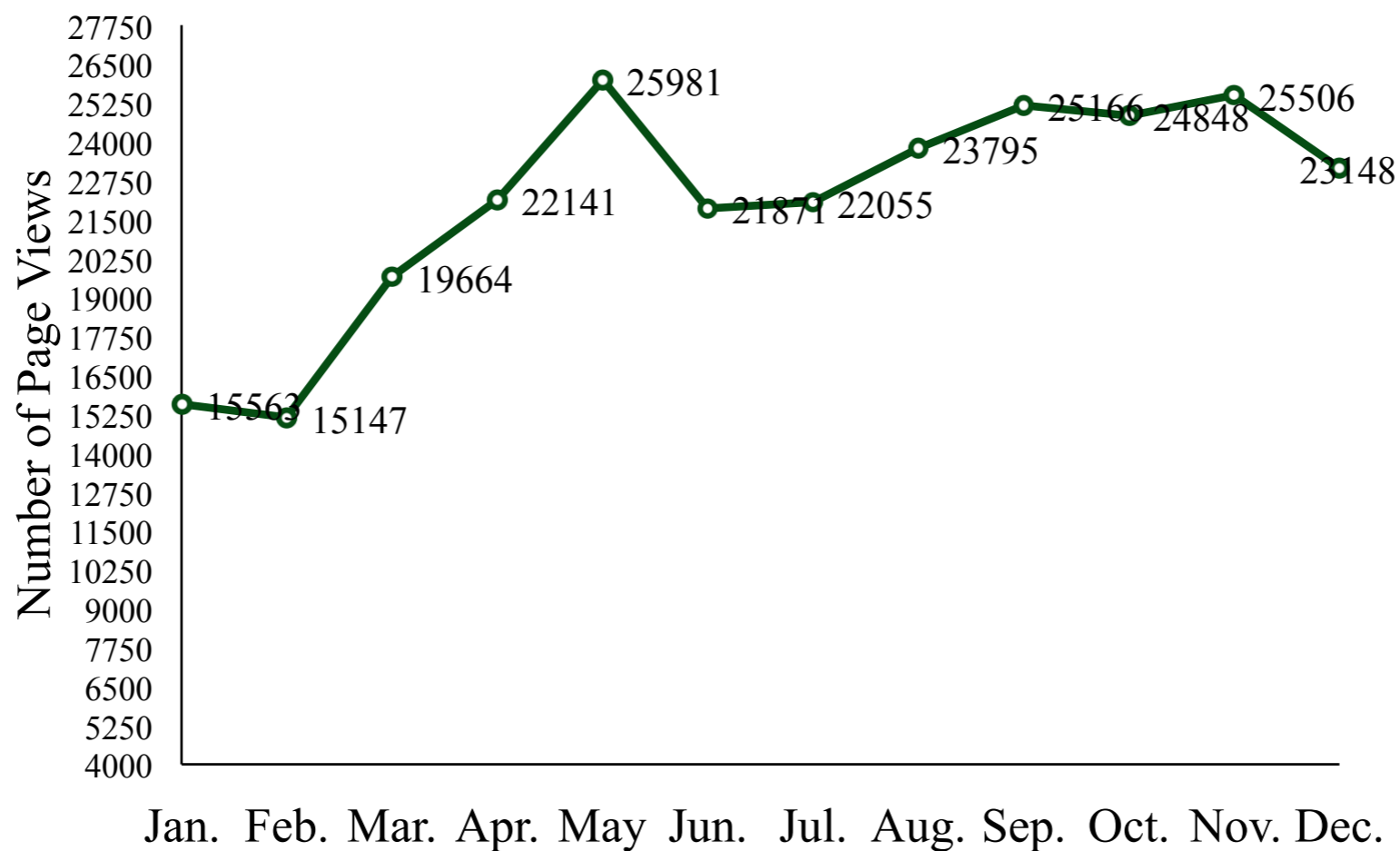

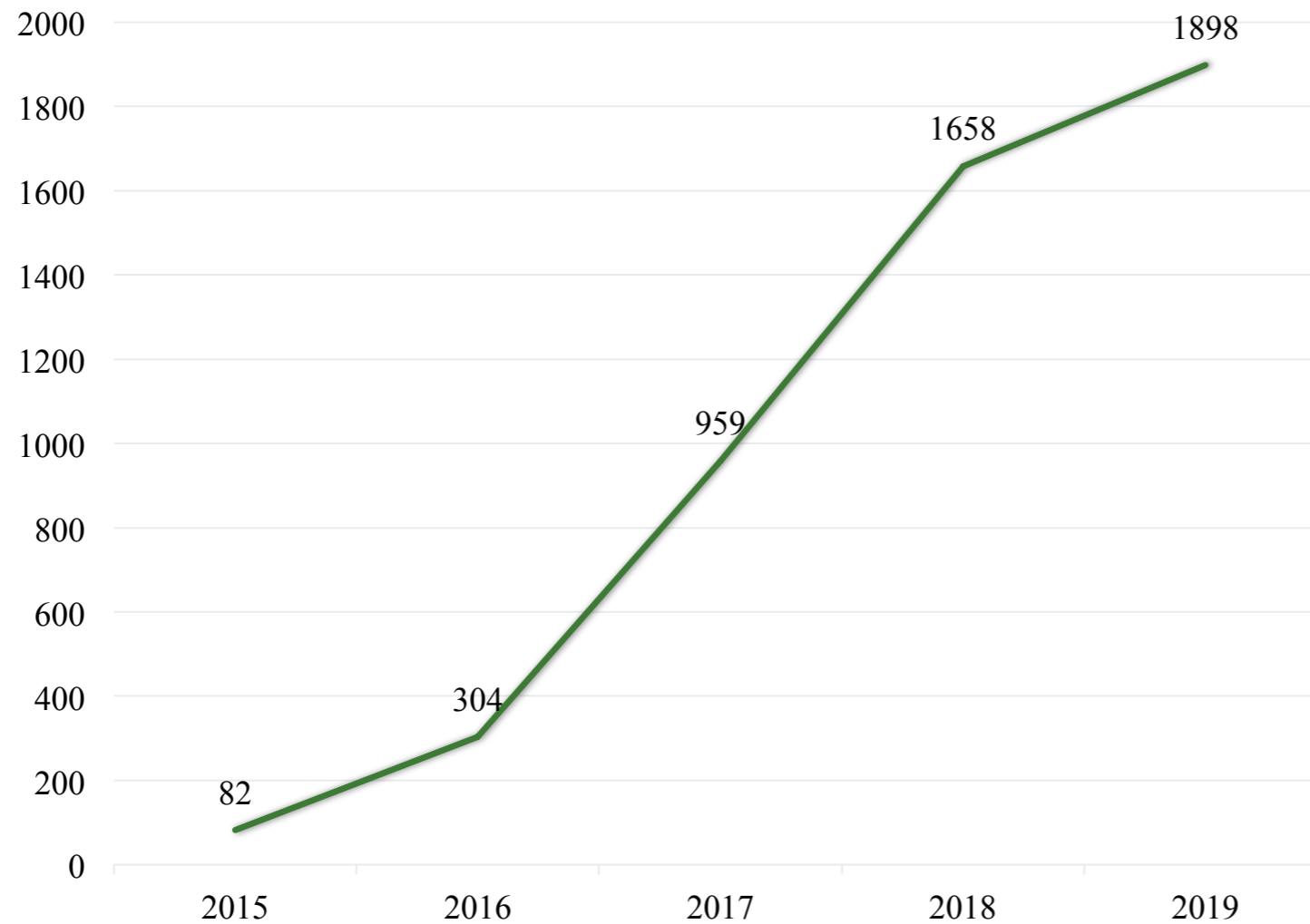
